Research: Releasing at least 3 papers this year helping to make the case for healthy communities



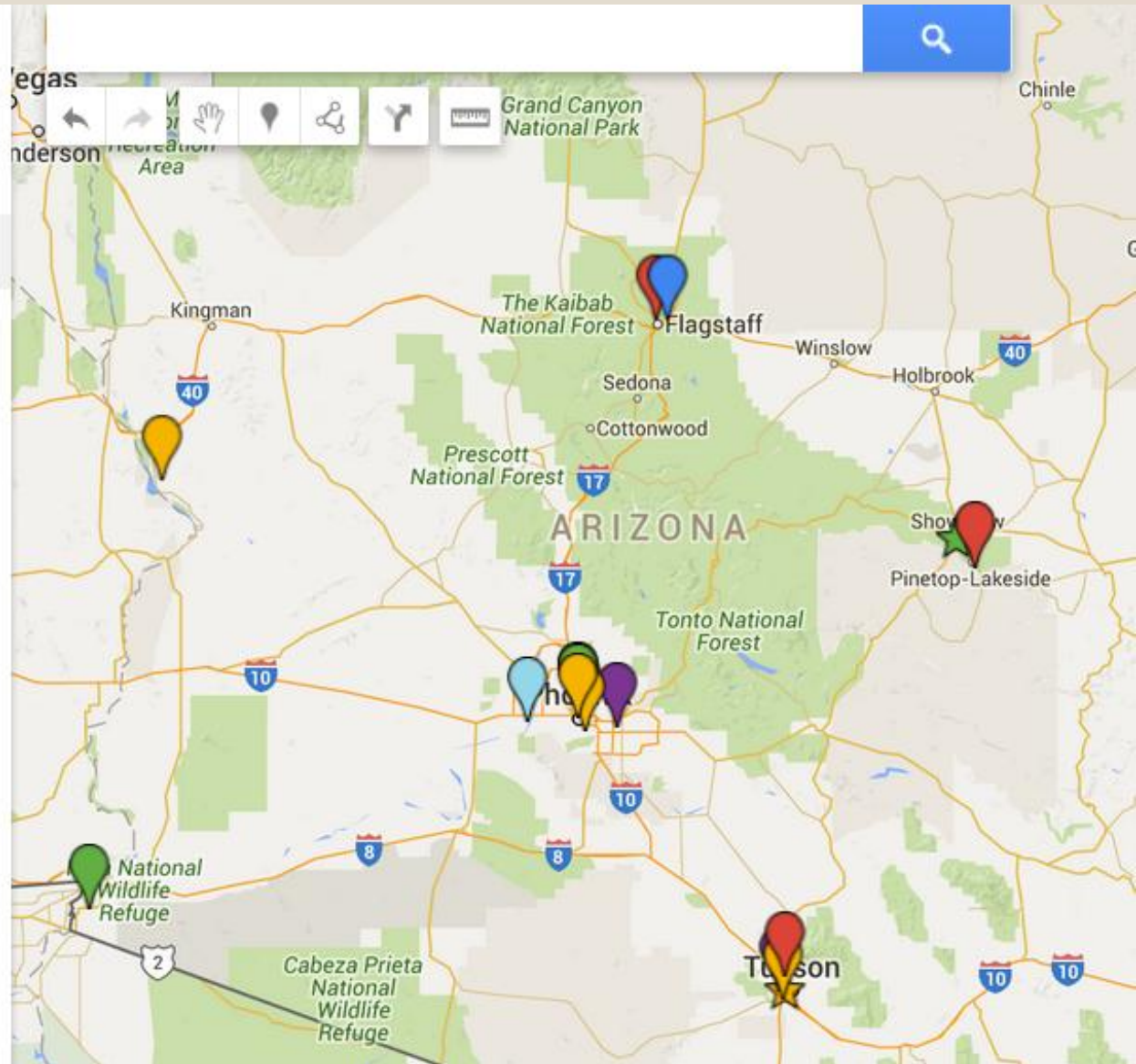
